

Beighton

Beighton Station was opened in June 1840 by the [North Midland Railway](#). It was just a halt at some distance from Beighton village and closed in January 1843. Two subsequent stations in different locations were built by the [Manchester, Sheffield and Lincolnshire Railway](#).

The station was regularly flooded by the [River Rother](#).

“The village on the left. Pass the boundary into Yorkshire.”

Beighton station closed for the final time in November 1954. It has since been demolished.
